

New Online Fire Loss Report Form

The Fire Protection Association has been collecting and publishing data on fire loss for many years. In recent months the FPA has been working collaboratively with Government (CLG) and the Chief Fire Officers Association to match insurer loss data with fire reports compiled by individual fire and rescue services as part of a study into the extent of financial loss associated with fires.

Insurers and Loss Adjusters are key to the data collection process through the submission of loss report forms to the FPA. Following discussions with Insurers and CILA an electronic version of the loss report form has now been produced, replacing the old Loss Report Forms A, B & C. Access to the forms will be via the FPA web site and completed online.

The new form will go online from April this year. It is anticipated that Loss Adjusting firms and Insurance companies will be able to access their own records in order to collect and analyse performance management information within the database.
